**LICENSING GUIDELINES**

Under Connecticut DMV guidelines, anyone who drives a motorcycle must obtain a Class M motorcycle license or motorcycle instruction permit.

Applicants must be 16 years of age, have a valid driver's license, pay a \$40 testing fee, complete a certificate of parental consent form if under eighteen, pass a vision exam, pass a sixteen question law

test, and pay a \$15 motorcycle permit fee. The final step is to pass the motorcycle skills test where you will demonstrate your competency in motorcycle operation.

Before you head to the Connecticut DMV office, make sure you have the following required documents to get your motorcycle license:

- Motorcycle permit
- Driver's license
- Motorcycle that you will be using for the road test
- Motorcycle registration
- Connecticut Insurance Card for the motorcycle
- Appointment confirmation letter that you received in the mail
- If the applicant is 16 or 17 years of age, you must present a certificate of successful completion of a basic motorcycle training course. You must also bring a parent, legal guardian, spouse over 18 years of age or a completed Certificate of Parental Consent, with a notarized seal.
